1. Registration and payment

- a. The registration form is your tax invoice. You can pay by electronic fund transfer, cheque, money order or credit card (MasterCard or Visa only). Cheques or money orders should be made payable to **Biometric Society Australasian Region**.
- b. No Australian GST is payable as the region is a 'not-for-profit' entity with turnover below AUD 150, 000.
- c. All credit card payments will be processed in Australia using the Australian dollar amount and converted, for members outside Australia, to the local currency amount by your financial institution on your card statement.
- d. Delegates can register by email, mail or fax.
- e. Receipts for registration will be issued within 7 days.
- f. The delegate's details (name, organisation and email address) will be listed in the conference booklet. If you do not wish to be included in this list please tick the relevant box on the registration form.

2. Conference venue and pre-conference workshops

- a. The venue for the conference is at the Sebel Harbourside Hotel in Kiama, New South Wales. Kiama is about 120 kilometres south of Sydney (the expected entry point for most delegates). Maps will be posted on the website soon.
- b. The conference registration includes the welcome reception from 6pm and a barbeque dinner from 7pm on Sunday December 4, 2011 at the Sebel Harbourside Hotel.; a satchel with a booklet of the programme and abstracts; morning and afternoon refreshments plus lunch on each of the conference days; and the conference dinner at Bellachara Boutique Hotel. Coaches will be organized to take delegates to the dinner on December 7, 2011 from 6.45pm at the Sebel Harbourside Hotel, returning between 10pm and 11pm.
- c. Accompanying guests are most welcome and details need to be completed for any one accompanying you. Extra fees apply to these guests for the social events. Please enter their details on the form. They will receive a proper badge.
- d. Day registration is available. This does not include the conference dinner.

- e. There are two pre-conference workshops on December 2 and 3, 2011 in Sydney and Wollongong respectively. Please see the full details on the website under the Satellite courses link.

 - b. You must submit an abstract by the due date of 31 August 2011.

 - a. Tours need to be paid for at the time of registration. The guided tours information is available in the Social document on the conference webpage via the Programme link.
 - b. There are many activities besides the guided tours that delegates and their guests can enjoy such as golfing or swimming. Some are described in the Social document on the website. Contact the Kiama Tourism centre or the Sebel Harbourside for more options.


